#### **DIV I**

1. Cl. 7-7.9, 25 Any – Victorian Glass, specialized to White. Use NBB Bulletin, July 2013 for reference. No clambroth/camphor allowed. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4

#### **DIV II**

2. Cl. 1-9.1 + Cl. 1-9.2 + 1-9.3, Medium – Transportation (Air, Land, Water). 10 from each class required. Label organization – refer to page 69 in Blue Book. Mount in 3 groups. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2

#### **DIV III**

- 3. Cl. 12-7.2, 25 Any Metalized Synthetic Polymers. No bakelite allowed. No points for different polymers. No balance necessary between different polymers. DO NOT label polymers. No limit on realistics. Leslie Denhard in memory of Pat Allen \$10-6-4
- 4. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 25 Any Pictorials, specialized to Red Glass. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 5. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 25 Any Pictorials, specialized to Studio Buttons. Label maker if known. 3 pts. per pictorial class, 2 pts. per maker, 1 pt. per material. No pts. for OME/DF. No balance necessary of pictorial sections. Kaye Reed \$5-3-2

## DIV VIIA and DIV VIIB JUNIORS All ages of Juniors can enter ANY of the DIV VIIA and DIV VIIB awards.

- 6. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 15 Any Pictorials, specialized to Things Found in Children's Books, Poems, Songs, Nursery Rhymes. No limit on realistics. No balance between books, poems, songs, nursery rhymes required. Label thing AND book/poem/song/nursery rhyme. Florida State Button Society \$5-3-2
- 7. Cl. 20-1, 15 Any Architectural Structures and/or Scenes. No balance required. Florida State Button Society \$5-3-2

#### **DIV IX**

- 8. Cl. 1-2.1.1 + 12-7.4.1, 25 Any Celluloid Painted and Buffed + Synthetic Polymers Painted and Buffed. Label at least 1 celluloid and 1 synthetic polymer. No balance of celluloid and synthetic polymers necessary. Other labeling not required but always helpful. No limit on realistics. Vicki MacTavish \$10-6-4
- 9. Cl. 2-0, 25 Any Ceramics Assorted. No more than 3 studios allowed. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 10. Cl. 2-2.1 + 2-2.2, 20 Any Ceramics (Arita, Kutani). Must have 10 from each class. Mount in 2 groups. Maryalice Ditzler \$10-6-4
- 11. Cl. 3-0, 15 Any China, specialized to One Color (Entrant's Choice) on white/cream and solid color body of that same color. Examples: White body calico with orange pattern, cream body with orange stencil, fish eye solid orange body. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 12. Cl. 6-0, Medium Black Glass Assorted. Labeling and mounting in class order not necessary but would be helpful to judges. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5
- 13. Cl. 6-6.2, 25 Any Black Glass, specialized to Faceted. Any amount of faceting ok. Shapes and number of facets not considered. Linda Wood \$5-3-2
- 14. Cl. 6-4.2.1 + 6-4.2.3, 25 Any Black glass Decorative Finishes assorted (Gold, Silver). Must have 5 gold, 5 silver, 5 with both gold/silver, and 10 free choice of those listed above. No other lusters allowed. Other DF (ex., paint) ok but no points given. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 15. Cl. 7-2, 25 Any Clear colorless glass. Look for OME and DF. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 16. Cl. 7-4.4, 30 Any Designs in Glass Surface (DIGS). Must have 5 buttons each in 6 different colors. Mount in color groups. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 17. Cl. 7-4.11, 42 Small Moonglows, specialized to Pink. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5
- 18. Cl. 7-6.7, 25 Any Glass, Clear and Colored, Watch Crystals. No limit on studio buttons. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 19. Cl. 10-15.1, 20 Any Specific Types, Inlay/overlay, specialized to Damascene. No limit on Ballestero created buttons. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 20. Cl. 11-9, 9 cards Unlisted specialized to shell buttons on original sales cards. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5

- 21. Cl. 14-2, 25 Any Unprocessed Wood. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 22. Cl. 15-5, 20 Any Unlisted, specialized to Cinnabar. Modern cinnabar allowed. Sue Moncrieff \$10-6-4
- 23. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 20 Any –Pictorials, specialized to things a meteorologist talks about in their weather report. E.g., rain, snow day schools closed (school bus), don't forget your umbrella, start of deer hunting season, groundhog day. No limit on realistics. Label 'thing'. No balance between sections necessary. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 24. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24 + Cl. 22-1, 25 or 26 Any Pictorials + Patterns, specialized to buttons matching each letter of the alphabet. Example: A for apple, P for Plaid. X is not required but 5 extra points given if you have an X for a total of 26 buttons. No balance necessary between sections. Linda Wood \$10-6-4
- 25. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24 + DIV II Cl. 1-0, 20 Any Pictorials, spec'd to One U.S. State + Uniform from United States Assorted, specialized to One U.S. State. The STATE MUST be clearly identified by name (not nickname). Must have at least 2 buttons from Div. II, Cl. 1-0. No balance necessary. Label each button as to State reference. No limit on realistics. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5
- 26. Cl. 17-1 + 17-3 + 17-4 + 17-6, 25 Any Animals (Amphibians, Fish, Invertebrates, Reptiles). No balance between sections necessary. Maryalice Ditzler \$10-6-4
- 27. Cl. 17-2.2, 25 Any Owls. Limit of 3 studio buttons. Maureen Grant \$10-8-5
- 28. Cl. 17-3 + 17-4 +17-5 + 17-6, 25 Any Fish, Invertebrates Assorted, Mammals Assorted, and Reptiles specialized to Sea (salt water) Animals. No balance between classes necessary. Label animal. Linda Wood \$10-5-3
- 29. Cl. 17-4.3, 20 Any Insects, specialized to Lady Bugs. Must have spots. No limit on realistics. Linda Wood in memory of Ann Whittle \$10-6-4
- 30. Cl. 17-4.1 + 18-12, 20 Any Arachnids, specialized to Spiders and Unlisted Objects, specialized to Spider Webs. Must have at least one button with spider and web on same button. No balance necessary. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 31. Cl. 17-5.4, 25 Any Dogs, specialized to Scottie Dogs. No limit on realistics. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 32. Cl. 18-0 + 20-17, 25 Any Objects + Pastimes/games/sports. No limit on realistics. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5

- 33. Cl. 18-1, 25 Any Anchors. No limit on realistics. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5
- 34. Cl. 18-12, 25 Any Unlisted, specialized to Bows. Other subject matter ok and bow does not need to be main focus. No people allowed. No balance necessary. No limit on realistics. Sue Moncrieff \$10-6-4
- 35. Cl. 18-6.4, 25 Any Hats, headdresses. Label hats, headdresses. No floral wreaths, bows, etc. Just flowers/bows are not considered hats or headdresses. No limit on realistics. 3 pts. for each different type of hat/headdress, 2 pts. for materials. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 36. Cl. 19-0, 25 Any Plants Assorted, spec'd to identifiable plant life. Metal buttons only. No points given for different metals or any balance of metals considered. Label plants. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 37. Cl. 19-2, 25 Any Flowers. 3 pts. for each labeled, different type of flower. 1 pt. for each different material. No limit on realistics. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 38. Cl. 20-3, 25 Any Astronomical, specialized to Stars. Just stars, nothing else. No limit on star shaped buttons. Marie Landeros Lira \$10-6-4
- 39. Cl. 20-5, 15 Any Children. Limited to those who have never entered a children award at any show. No teens allowed. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 40. Cl. 20-18, 20 Any People, specialized to Kate Greenaway. Buttons must be recognizable as coming from Kate's drawings (some are not exact). Limit of 4 studios. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
- 41. Cl. 20-8 + 20-10, 25 Any Fabulous Creatures + Gnomes, fairies, sprites. No limit on realistics. Manatee Button Club \$10-8-5
- 42. Cl. 20-11, 15 Any Heads, specialized to women's profiles. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 43. Cl. 22-1.2.4, 25 Any Paisley. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
- 44. Cl. 22-1.5.1, 20 Any Cross Linear Designs. 3 pts for each material. Modified crosses are allowed, eg., Non-right angle crosses or crosses with more than one crossbar. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
