DIV I 1. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 25 Any – Pictorials, specialized to Horn. President, Vicki MacTavish in honor of all of my horny measles. \$30-20-10

DIV VIIA and DIV VIIB JUNIORS

All ages of Juniors can enter ANY of the DIV VIIA and DIV VIIB awards.

2. DIV IX Cl. 17-5, 15 Any – Mammals. No limit on realistics. Limit of 2 studios. Linda Gass \$5-3-2

3. DIV IX Cl. 18-11 + 20-17 – 15 Any – Sports, game equipment and Pastimes/games/sports. No limit on realistics. Limit of 2 studios. Florida State Button Society \$5-3-2

DIV I

4. Cl. 6-3.11, 25 Any – Tile Type. Vicki MacTavish \$10-6-4

5. Cl. 7-1.4 + 7-4.13 + 7-4.14 + 7-7.7, Small – Cl/Col Glass, specialized to 10 Swirlbacks, 10 Paperweights, 10 Radiants, 10 Lacy, and 2 free choice of the 4 classes listed above. Mount in groups. No need for labeling but would be helpful to competitors and judges. Maureen Grant, in memory of Roberta Miller. \$20-10-5

6. Cl. 7-7.7 – 25 Medium– Lacy Glass. No lacy-like allowed. Vicki MacTavish \$10-6-4

7. Cl. 10-12-4. 25 Any – Metals with Original Tint/Finish. Maryalice Ditzler \$10-6-4

DIV III

8. Cl. 2-0 + 6-5.3.1 + 7-6.3.1, 20 Any – Ceramic, specialized to Bimini, Black Glass and Cl/Col Glass Bimini/Bimini-like. No balance between black and cl/col glass necessary. Up to 2 ceramic bimini allowed (but not required) and the ceramics must be backmarked with the tree. Up to 3 points given for different backmarks. No studios allowed. North Florida Button Club \$10-6-4

9. Cl. 6-3-8, 20 Any – Black Glass Moonglows. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4

10. Cl. 7-4.11 – 25 Any – Cl/Col. Glass Moonglows. North Florida Button Club \$10-6-4

11. Cl. 7-5.2.2 – 25 Any – Cl/Col Glass with Iridescent/Aurora Decorative Finish. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2

12. Cl. 11-1.1, 25 Any – Bethlehem Pearl, specialized to Religious Subject Matter. Manatee Button Club \$10-5-3

DIV IV

13. Cl. 2-1, 8 Any – Buckles/Clasps type, specialized to assorted materials. Must have 3 two-piece, 3 one-piece, and 2 free choice (of any number of pieces). Maryalice Ditzler \$10-6-4

DIV IX

14. Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, 12 Any – Assorted Materials, specialized to buttons 2” or larger. Lisa Miller \$15-10-5

15. Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, 25 Any – Astronomical, specialized to Moons and/or Stars. No balance necessary. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4

16. Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, Diminutive – Assorted Materials. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4

17. Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, 15 Pairs – Assorted Materials, specialized to Matching Pairs. Pairs can be medium-small, medium-large, large-small. No balance on sizes required. Lynette Brown \$5-3-2

18. Cl. 1-5.1 + 12-9.5, 25 Any – Celluloid with Rhinestones/pastes OME and Synthetic Polymers with Rhinestones/pastes OME. No points for different polymers or celluloid. No balance necessary between sections/classes. DO NOT label celluloid or polymers. No points given for rarities. Carol Lemieux \$5-3-2

19. Cl. 3-0, Small – China Assorted, specialized to blue or orange DF, on white or cream body. Try for as many body types as possible. Equal number of blue and orange not required but must include at least 18 of each. Jane Quimby \$10-7-5

20. Cl. 4-0, 25 Any – Enamel. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2

21. Cl. 5-5.1, 25 Any - Backgrounds Mounted in/on metal, specialized to Velvet. Barbara Wells \$10-6-4

22. Cl. 6-0, 25 Any - Black Glass Assorted. Mounting in class order not necessary but would be helpful to judges. Central Florida Button Club \$6-4-2
23. Cl. 6-4.2.1, Small – Black glass with Gold Luster. Any amount of Gold luster okay. No other lusters allowed. Manatee Button Club \$10-5-3
24. Cl. 7-4.1 + 7-4.3 + 7-4.12 + 7-4.14 + 7-6.5, 25 Any – Clear & Colored Glass Blown, Crackle, Overlay, Radiant, Precision Inlay (no insets allowed). Must have 5 from each class. Mount in groups by class. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
25. Cl.10-0, 25 Any - Metals Assorted, specialized to the 4 pictorial sections. North Florida Button Club \$10-6-4
26. Cl. 10-5 + 10-8, 25 Small – Steel and Brass, specialized to those with riveted cut steel. Any amount of cut steels okay. Look for different shapes and tints of steels. Linda Hopgood \$10-6-4
27. Cl. 11-0, 20 Any – Shell Assorted, specialized to Realistics. No studios allowed. Sara Mulford \$15-10-5
28. Cl. 13-0, 25 Any – Vegetable Ivory, specialized to shapes. Limit of 5 round buttons. Limit of 5 realistics. Limit of 3 studio buttons. Label each shape. Lynette Brown \$10-6-4
29. Cl. 17-0 thru 19-10 + 20-18, 25 Any – Pictorials, specialized to ‘Things Seen in a House’. Only 2 buttons from Cl. 20-18 allowed. No balance necessary. Label ‘Things’. No limit on realistics. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
30. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 25 Any – Pictorials, specialized to ‘Christmas themed buttons. No more than 15 realistics allowed. 2 Points for each material. North Florida Button Club \$10-6-4
31. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 20 Any – Pictorials, specialized to ‘Things seen/ found in Alaska’ including lakes, streams, and surrounding waters. No limit on realistics. Helen Acker in honor of Clara Jo Minnick \$10-6-4
32. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24, 20 Any – Pictorials, specialized to Sew Thru. No studios allowed. Jane Quimby \$10-7-3
33. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24 + 22-1L, 25 Any – Pictorials, specialized to ‘Song Titles’. LIMITED to members that have competed for 5 years or less. Must include ONLY 1 button from Cl. 22-1 (labeling of pattern not required). Label song title. No limit on realistics. Anonymous \$5-3-2

34. Cl. 17-0 thru 20-24 + 22-1, 25 Any – Pictorials, specialized to ‘Song Titles’. Must include ONLY 1 button from Cl. 22-1 (labeling of pattern not required). Label song title. No limit on realistics. Anonymous \$5-3-2
35. Cl. 17-1, 25 Any – Amphibians, specialized to Frogs. No limit on realistics. Beth Beaupre \$10-6-4
36. Cl. 17-2, 25 Any – Birds Assorted, specialized to 5 owls, 5 peacocks, 5 swans, 5 domestic fowl, and 5 wading, water birds. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
37. CL. 17-5, 25 Any - Mammals assorted. North Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
38. Cl. 17-5.6 – 25 Any – Horses, specialized to Horses only (no other horse family animals allowed). Riders and/or vehicles permitted. No 18thC allowed. Maggie Johnson in honor of Lynette Brown \$5-3-2
39. Cl. 18-12 + 20-5 + 20-6, 20 Any – Unlisted, specialized to Dolls, Children, and Cherubs. Must have 4 dolls, 4 children, 4 babies, 4 cherubs (no wings), and 4 free choice of above. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
40. Cl. 19-0, 25 Any – Plants Assorted, specialized to plants found in Florida. Label plant. Manatee Button Club \$5-3-2
41. Cl. 20-11, Small – Heads. Honoring all of our members dealing with medical issues. \$5-3-2
42. Cl. 20-18, 20 Any – People, specialized to people doing an activity. (ex – man sitting on a bench is NOT an activity). Cathy Mayer \$10-7-3
43. Cl. 20-22.1.2, 20 Any - Land Transportation, specialized to Racing Cars. No limit on studios or realistics. Central Florida Button Club \$5-3-2
44. Cl. 22-2.1, 20 Any – Letter/word (verbal), specialized to the Letter V. This award honors Queen Victoria and Victory of WWII. The buttons must represent a V in some fashion (stylized okay) and may or may not have been produced for Victoria or Victory (as many are not known, for sure). Anne Hudson \$15-10-5
45. Cl. 23-9, Small – Materials Mounted in/on Metal, specialized to Waistcoat-Like Buttons. Sandy Arthur \$10-6-4
46. Cl. 23-12 – 25 Any – Specific Types Unlisted, specialized to Birmingham Trade. Bay Area Button Club \$10-6-4
